# Bomaderry High School Aboriginal Student 'In Class Tutor' Position

In Class Tutor (part time 2 days/week - Tuesdays and Wednesdays only). The position starts 27th April, 2016 and ends 26th October, 2016 due to available funding.

#### **Role Statement:**

To assist identified Aboriginal students requiring literacy and numeracy support. The position will operate on Tuesdays 9.00am-5.30pm and Wednesdays 9.00am - 3.00pm.

#### **Position Criteria:**

Candidates must demonstrate:

- An ability to assist Year 8 and 10 students with literacy and numeracy skills.
- Effective communication with students, teachers and the Aboriginal Education Officer.
- An understanding of Aboriginal community and culture.
- A willingness to organise and supervise the operation of the Aboriginal Homework Centre 3.30pm - 5.30pm every Tuesday.
- An ability to keep accurate records.

The applicant must possess a relevant Australian teaching qualification. Tutor pay rates are \$55.18 per hour.

Applications must be no more than two A4 pages in length. The application should include:

- 1. A statement addressing the position criteria.
- 2. Educational qualifications.
- 3. Current and previous employment and skills.
- 4. Details of two (2) referees including their position, location and contact information.

Successful applicants will be subject to a criminal record check at the applicant's expense (\$80.00).

Raising Resilient Teenagers: A Free Online Program for Parents.

FREE online parenting program empowering parents to make sense of adolescence and parent their teenager with confidence.

As children become teenagers, it can be hard for parents to know the best way to stay connected with their child. Parents can play an important role in increasing resilience in their teenagers and protecting their mental health.

Researchers from Monash University and the University of Melbourne have recently developed a new online parenting program that offers practical strategies parents can use to manage the challenges of adolescence and stay connected with their teenager.

If you are a parent or guardian of a child aged 12 to 15, you may be eligible to participate in a free trial of the program. Participation will take a few hours of yours and your child's time, over 3 months. Both you and your child will be reimbursed for your time.
