Public Notice - Public Exhibition of the Shoalhaven Regional Sporting Hub Master Plan -

The draft Shoalhaven Regional Sports & Community Precinct Master Plan seeks to develop Artie Smith Oval and Bomaderry Sporting Complex (both located within Bomaderry) with high quality sporting facilities to support local, regional and state level sport. In addition, the plan provides open space and community facilities which include a community pavilion providing support services that have the potential to provide aquatic, medical, physiotherapy, rehabilitation health, wellness and fitness services. This is a long term plan for the next 40 years and is intended to meet the needs of a growing community now and into the future.

The community is invited to comment on the draft Master Plan which is available for viewing on Council's website and at Council's Administration building, Council libraries, as well as the Bomaderry Aquatic Centre. Additionally, Council will be holding two (2) community “drop in” information sessions (unstructured opportunity to talk one on one with Council staff) on Wednesday, 6th July 2016 at the Bomaderry Aquatic Centre from 11am - 1pm and 5pm - 7pm.

The exhibition period will run for a period no less than 40 days commencing Wednesday, 1st June 2016. Submissions are due by close of business on Tuesday, 26th July 2016. Submissions made to Council in relation to this proposal will be considered as public documents.
