**Equity Scholarships** - This is for financial assistance for tertiary study. Apply through the ES online on UAC's website at [uac.edu.au/equity/apply](http://uac.edu.au/equity/apply).

**Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS)** - You must first apply through the UAC process, visit [uac.edu.au/srs](http://uac.edu.au/srs) and select SRS apply on the right hand side of the page to start your application. (SRS is for early entry to a range of universities other than UOW).

**EAS (Educational Access Scheme)** - If you feel your performance in the HSC has been hampered by health, financial, disruptive schooling etc. you can apply through the EAS scheme. See Mrs Van Beek for help.
