To refresh your memory, these were; an ability to **communicate** and **collaborate** with others and the capacity to **think critically** and **creatively** in a variety of situations. Over the next few weeks we will look at each of these skills in more detail and think about their importance in the workplace.

Communication

- Employers consistently identify the 10 communication skills below as the most desirable in young workers.
- Listening skills. Being a good listener is one of the best ways to be a good communicator
- Nonverbal communication. Your body language, eye contact, hand gestures, and tone all colour the message you are trying to convey
- Clarity and Concision
- Friendliness
- Confidence
- Empathy
- Open-Mindedness
- Respect
- Giving and receiving feedback
- Choosing an appropriate medium to communicate

How many of these skills do you have already? Are there any areas where you could improve? If you start working on your communication style now, you never know where it could lead!
