Bus Lines Procedures -

Bomaderry High School has a policy in regard to how students catch buses when leaving the school in the afternoon. Apart from buses Early I, Early Y and 5, all other students must wait in the bus lines area which is in front of B Block. They must wait until their bus is called by the teacher on duty.
